Field excursion:

Two-day field excursion visiting Quaternary marine, lacustrine and fluvial sites in Slovenia, Italy and Croatia.

9. 10. 2020: start from Ljubljana // Lake sediments in lake **Bohinj**, glaciofluvial sediments at **Most na Soči**, terrace at **Gorizia**, **Renče** clay pit // dinner and sleeping somewhere near Nova Gorica.

10. 10. 2020: LGM and paleosoil at **Tapogliano**, **Aquilea/Belvedere** dunes, Gulf of Trieste marine and fluvial deposits, geo-archeology in **Zambratija Bay**, **Mirna** river delta // transfer to Ljubljana.

Maximum number of participants: 35.

Registration fee, excursion cost:
