Abstract Submission

Abstracts should be sent to geoalp@bbtinfo.eu

Abstracts should be written in English and not exceed five type-written A4 page and two text figures. Please use Times New Roman font and 1.5 line spacing throughout the text. The title should be in capital bold letters, centred and at 14 points font size. Name(s) of the author(s), affiliation(s) and present mailing and e-mail addresses should be centred below the title after one free space and at 12 points font size. The main text should follow after another free space. Please follow the following example.

The main text should be written at 12 points font size, left-justified.

Please, avoid hyphenating words and figures.

If references are added in the text, cite them with the name of the author(s) in lowercase followed by the year of publication (Andrews, 1970). References should be listed at the end of the main text in alphabetic order of author's names.
